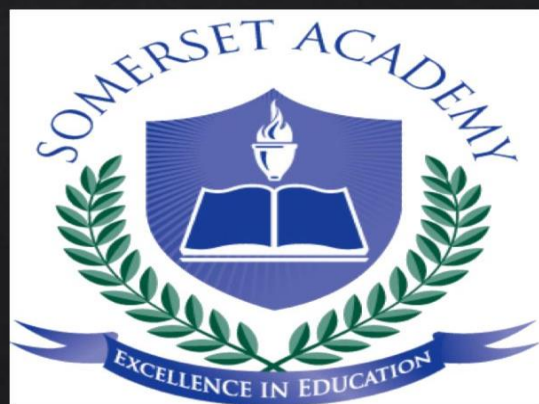


# SOMERSET PURPOSE

# Tardy—being late to class.

Being tardy to periods 2, 3, or 4 is accompanied by a detention.

**Period 2, 3, 4 teachers *write* & submit the detention.**

Being tardy to 1<sup>st</sup> period is a detention if you are a bus rider and your bus was on time.

Being tardy to 1<sup>st</sup> period and you are not a bus rider is a detention for every 3<sup>rd</sup> occurrence.

\*Does not apply to excused tardies.





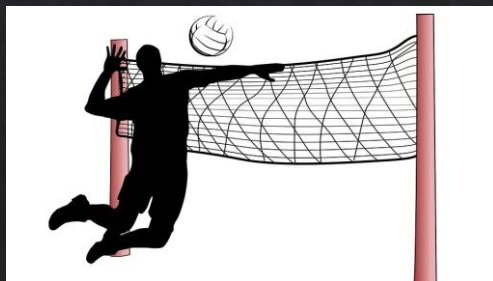


## TURF DURING LUNCH
