

Tardy—being late to class. Being tardy to periods 2, 3, or 4 is accompanied by a detention.

Being tardy to 1st period and you are not a bus rider is a detention for every 3rd occurrence.






You can register online to take these tests at various locations. See your guidance counselor for help registering or to see if you qualify for a fee reduction.
