SGA will not be taking cash order for crumble this year, so all orders must be online.

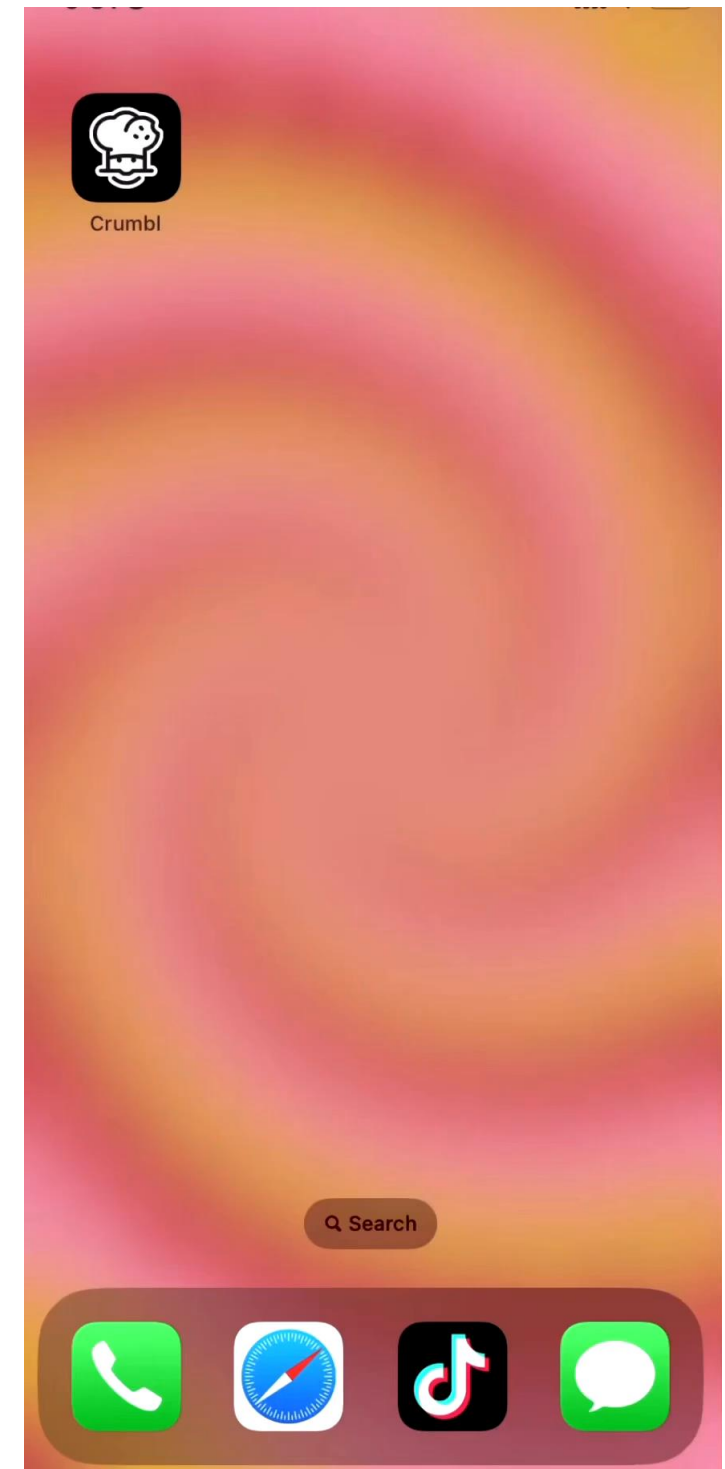

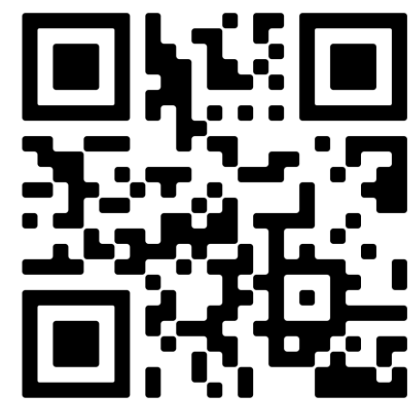

SPARTANS SWIM & DIVE

TOI

- The Somerset Spartans participated in the TOI a preliminary, finals meet at Indian River State College on Saturday. There were over 400 athletes representing 18 schools. Somerset Ladies placed 14th with 76 points and the Somerset Men placed 10th with 132.
- During a Preliminary/Finals meet only those athletes qualifying to come back to finals score for the team. We had 5 Spartans, 4 of which were double qualifier, to go on to compete in Finals in 9 events, to give Somerset the overall team placement of 13th
- Spartans returning to Finals were 8th grader Chace Richards, in the 200 Freestyle and the 100 Butterfly. Chace entered the 200 Free seeded in 9th place and finished 7th in his Finals race. In the 100 Butterfly Chace was seeded 14th going into finals and finished 12th.
- Sophomore Gunner Comer also qualified for Finals in the 200 Freestyle finishing 20th in that event.
- Sophomore Tyler Campbell, with an 8th place seed in the 200 IM, a tender shoulder forced Tyler to scratch the 200 IM Finals and focus on the 500 Freestyle where he placed 5th. The highest place finishers for the Somerset Spartans.
- Alec Sonne, 8th Grade qualified in the Finals in the 200IM and 500 Freestyle. In the 200 IM, Alec was seeded 17th going into preliminaries, 15th going into Finals and finished in 12th place overall dropping 9.41 seconds for a personal best time. In the 500 Freestyle, alec was seeded 16th going into prelims, 12th going into Finals and finished in 11th place, dropping 22.57 seconds off his best time.
- Freshman, Brisa Darden, was the lone Lady Spartan to qualify for Finals in Saturday's competition. Brisa qualified in the 50 and 100 Freestyle. Dropping 0.67 seconds in the 50 free and 3.31 seconds in the 100 Freestyle with a 15th place finish in both events..
- The Spartans had 31 Personal Best times during the Preliminary meet. Ivana Acosta in the 200 Freestyle and 100 Back. Sterling Prettlet in the 200 and 50 Freestyle. Christian Renken in the 200 Freestyle. Ava Giddens in the 200 IM, Ocean Prettelt in the 200 IM. Aidan Lawrence in the 50 Free, Jacob Abraham in the 50 Free. Mia Santiago in the 100 Fly. Nataley Wilson in the 100 Fly and 100 Back. Javien Cabrere in the 100 Fly. Sofia Mendez in the 100 Free. Catcher Lingen in the 100 Free and 100 Back. Adrian Gonzalez in the 100 Back. Tori Huckstep in the 100 Back. Amaya Padilla in the 100 Back.
- Today, the Spartans travel back to Okeechobee for an Relay Invitational.

Interested in starting a school club?

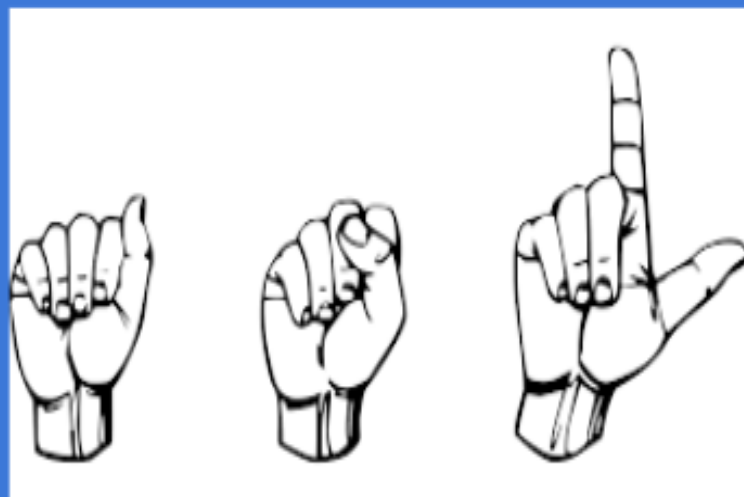
- If you're interested in starting a school club, you should do the following:

 - Talk to someone in administration about getting your club approved. Tell them who the sponsor is, when the club will occur (lunch or afterschool), and what the club entails.
